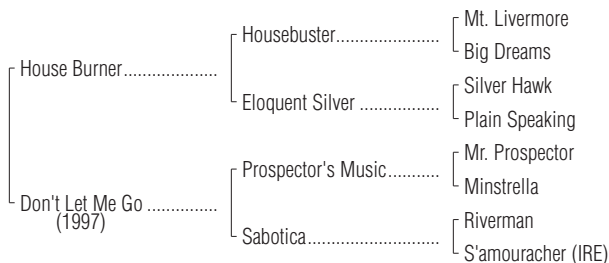


**Dark Bay or

**By HOUSE BURNER** (1997). Stakes-placed winner of 5 races at 2 and 3, \$155,017, 2nd WHAS-11 S.-L, Tyro S.-L, 3rd Sapling S.-**G3**. Sire of 3 crops of racing age, 13 foals, 5 starters, 2 winners of 2 races and earning \$67,280 in N.A., She Burns Sum (at 3, 2007, \$44,610), He Dances Backward (\$16,730). Son of champion Housebuster, sire of 35 stakes winners, including Hong Kong horse of the year Electronic Unicorn, and of Morluc (11 wins, \$648,338, in N.A., Aegon Turf Sprint S.-**G3**, etc.).
